MY FREE FAIRY WINGS:

I am offering three free butterfly wings that are set up to print on labels. There is a link for the free wings at <http://www.whitegothic.com/EmailInvitation.htm>. I use Avery Labels 5164 or 8164, the label sheet that has 6 labels on it. They are mirror images of themselves and if you cut both sides out, remove the non-stick backing and stick them together, you will have a beautiful, colourful butterfly fairy wing set that simply glues onto the back of your dolls. This whole technique and process is shown in the Baby Fairy DVD, but if you don't have the DVD, it's pretty simple to figure out.

BUTTERFLY WING CANE TUTORIAL:

This is a great tutorial for creating a butterfly cane from polymer clay. It is one of the best ones I have ever seen. This is another option for wings, using polymer clay. I hope you enjoy it.
