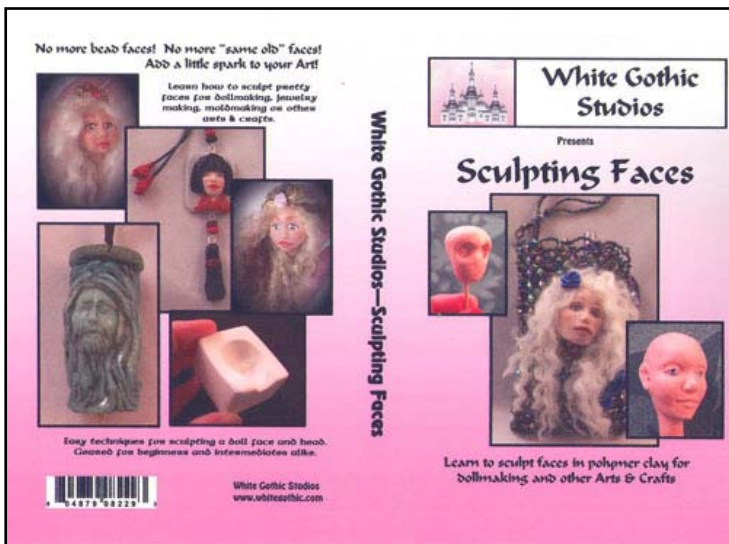


SEPTEMBER NEWSLETTER FROM WHITE GOTHIC STUDIOS:

Sculpting Faces. It started out as a “mini” tutorial, but wound up being 90 minutes long. It is shot in close up, takes you through my process of sculpting heads and faces, using an inner skull which makes it easier to sculpt without losing your features as you move around the head. 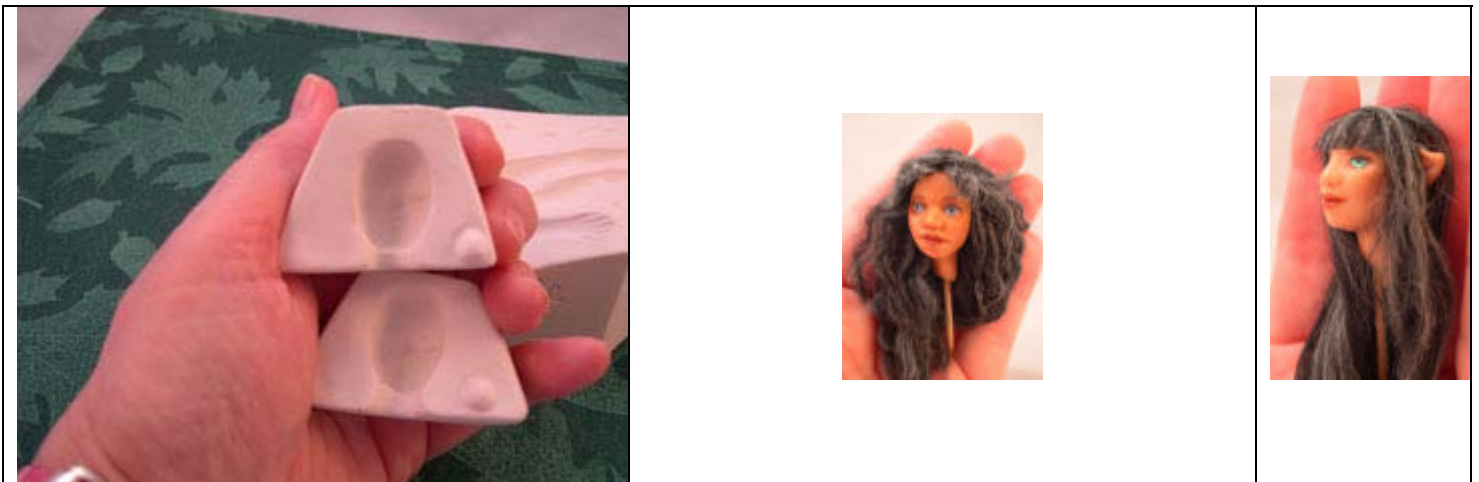
